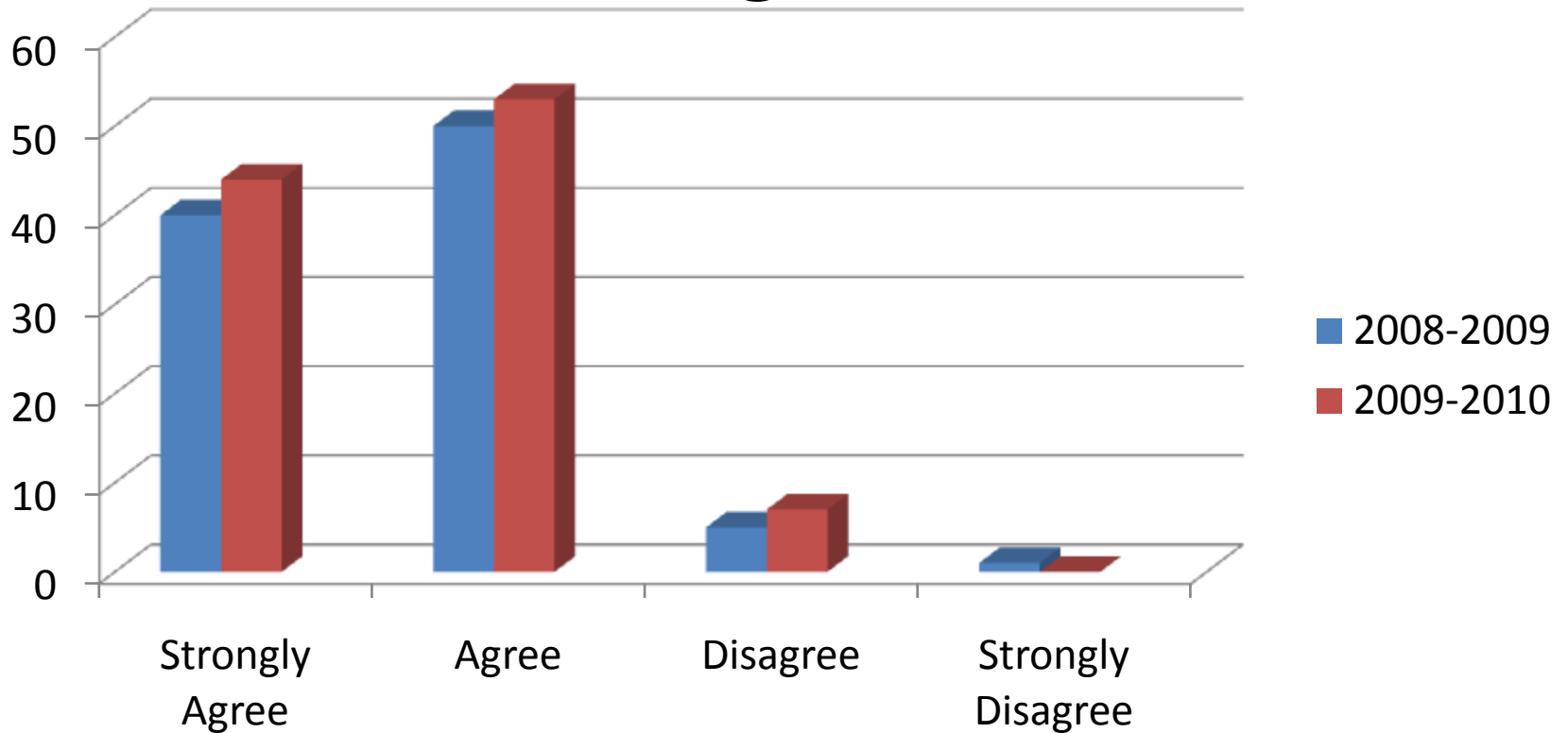


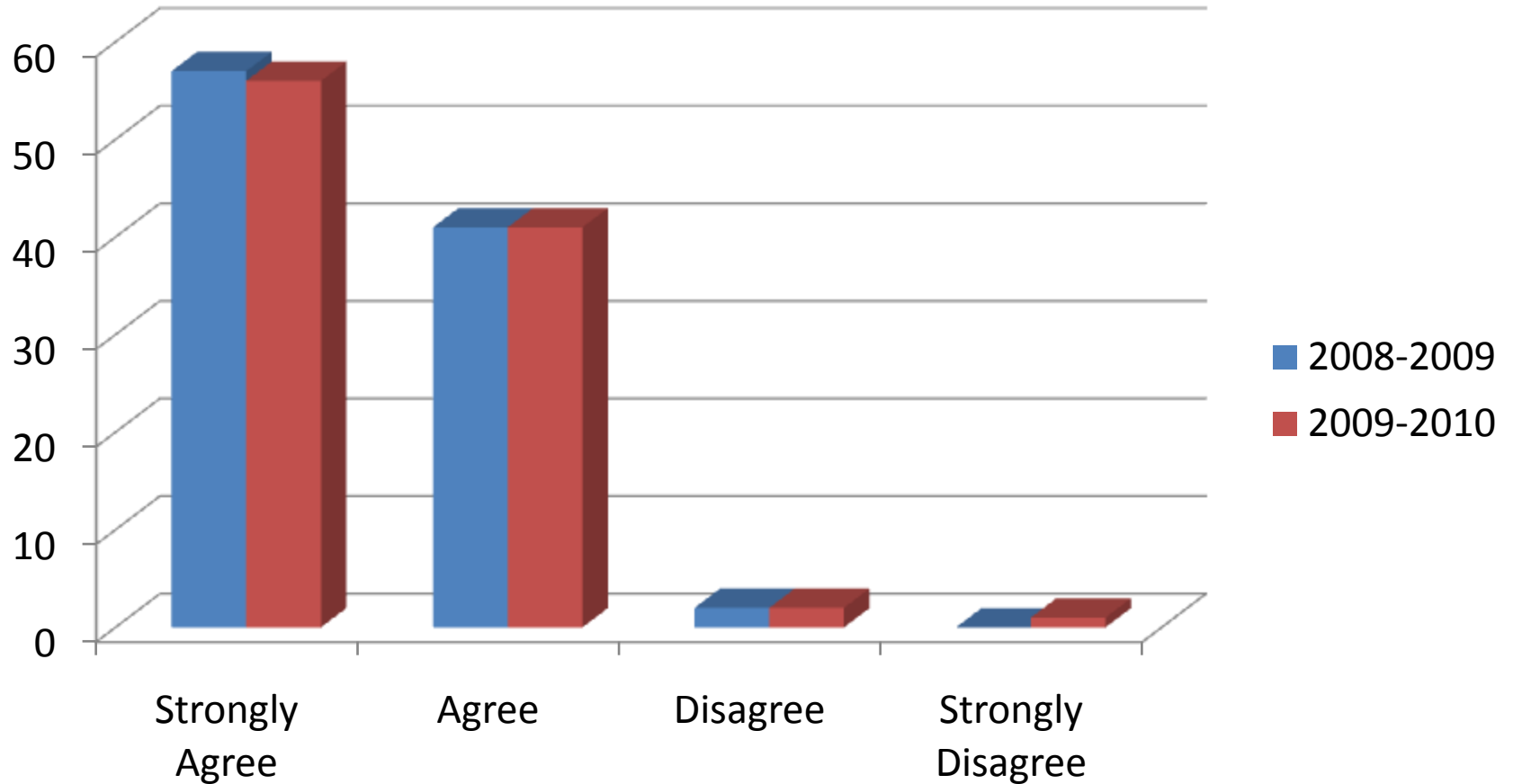

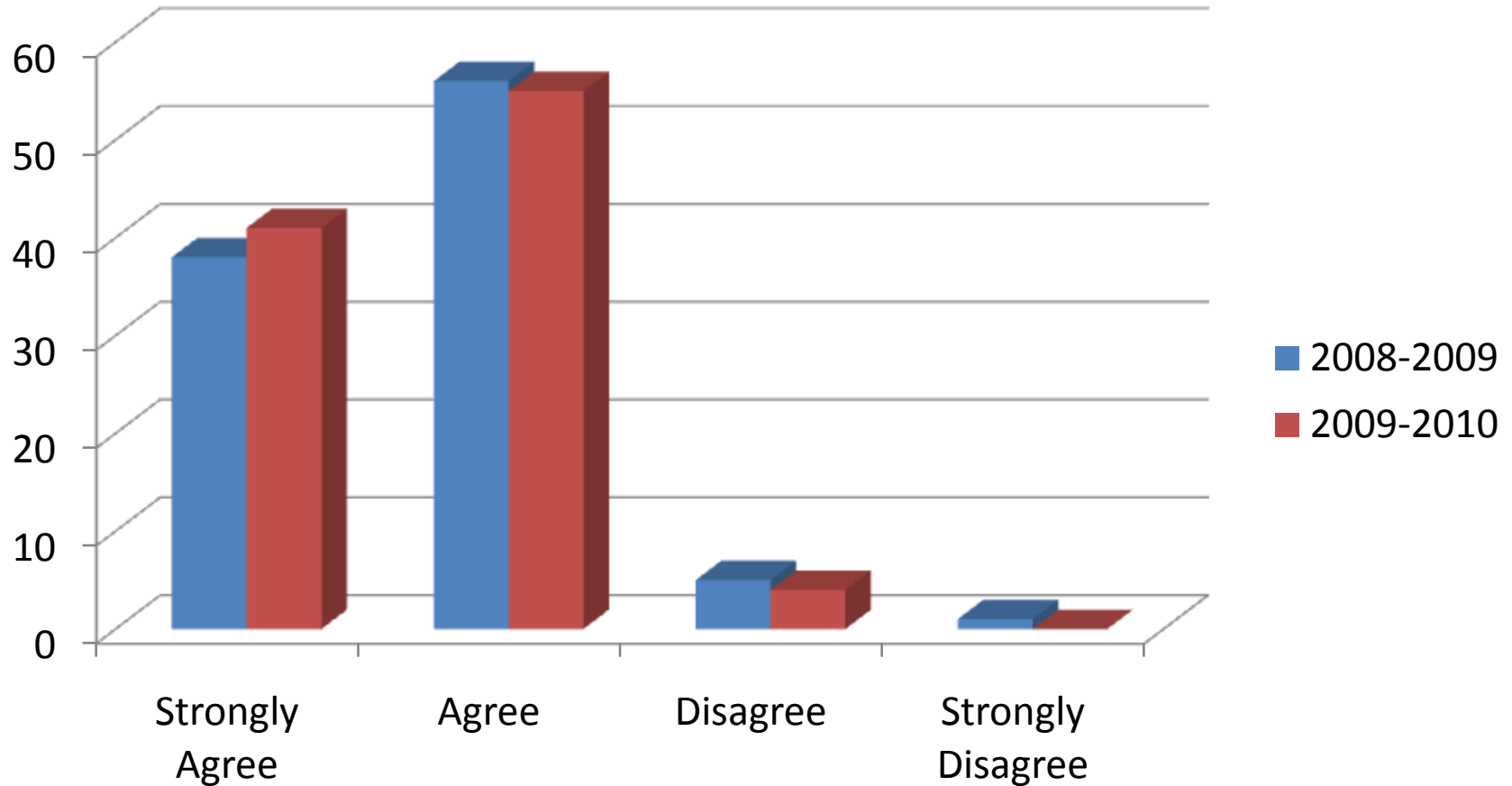
# The academic needs of my child are being met.



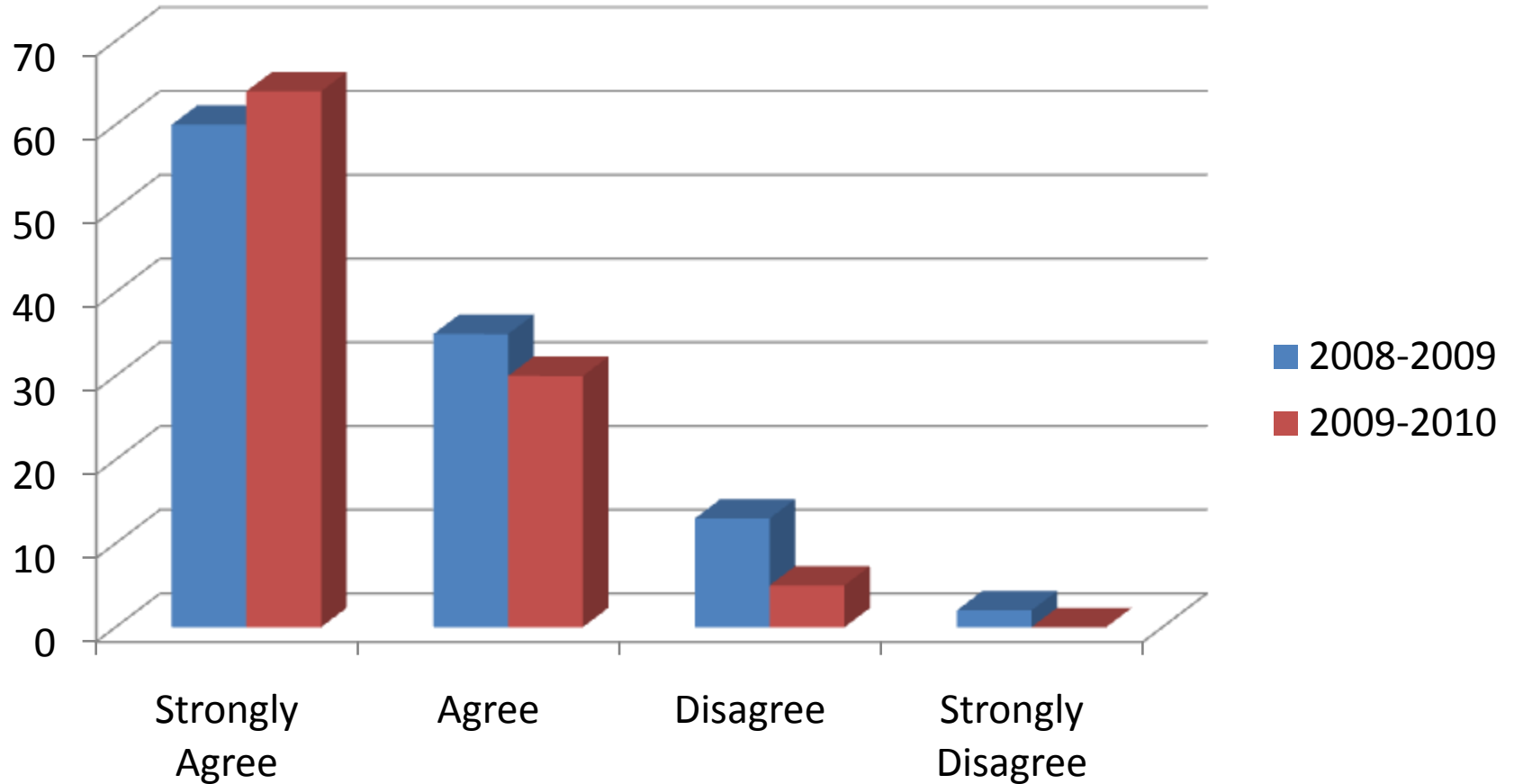
# The school provides a positive learning environment.



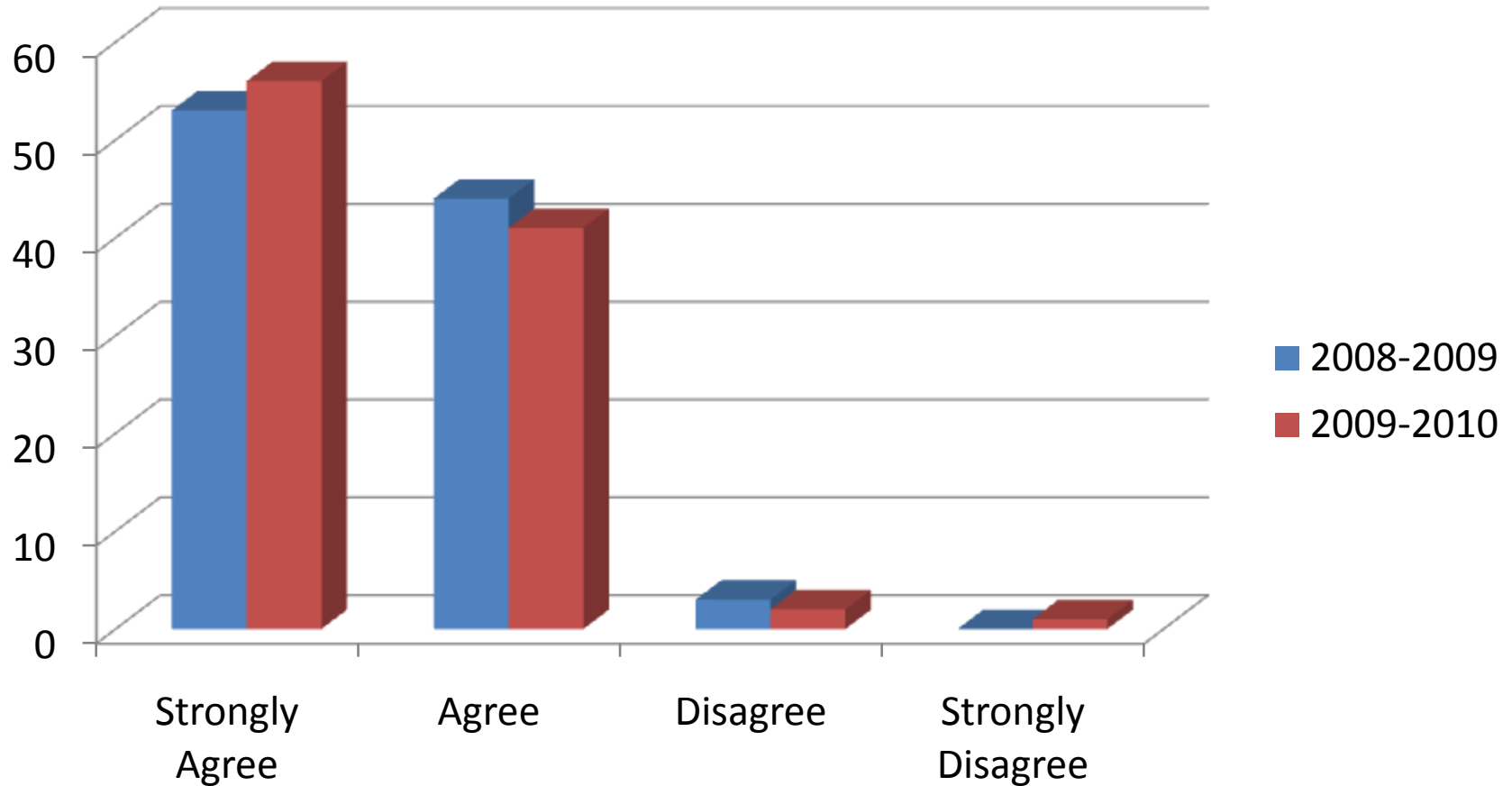
# Homework assignments are extensions of classroom learning activities.



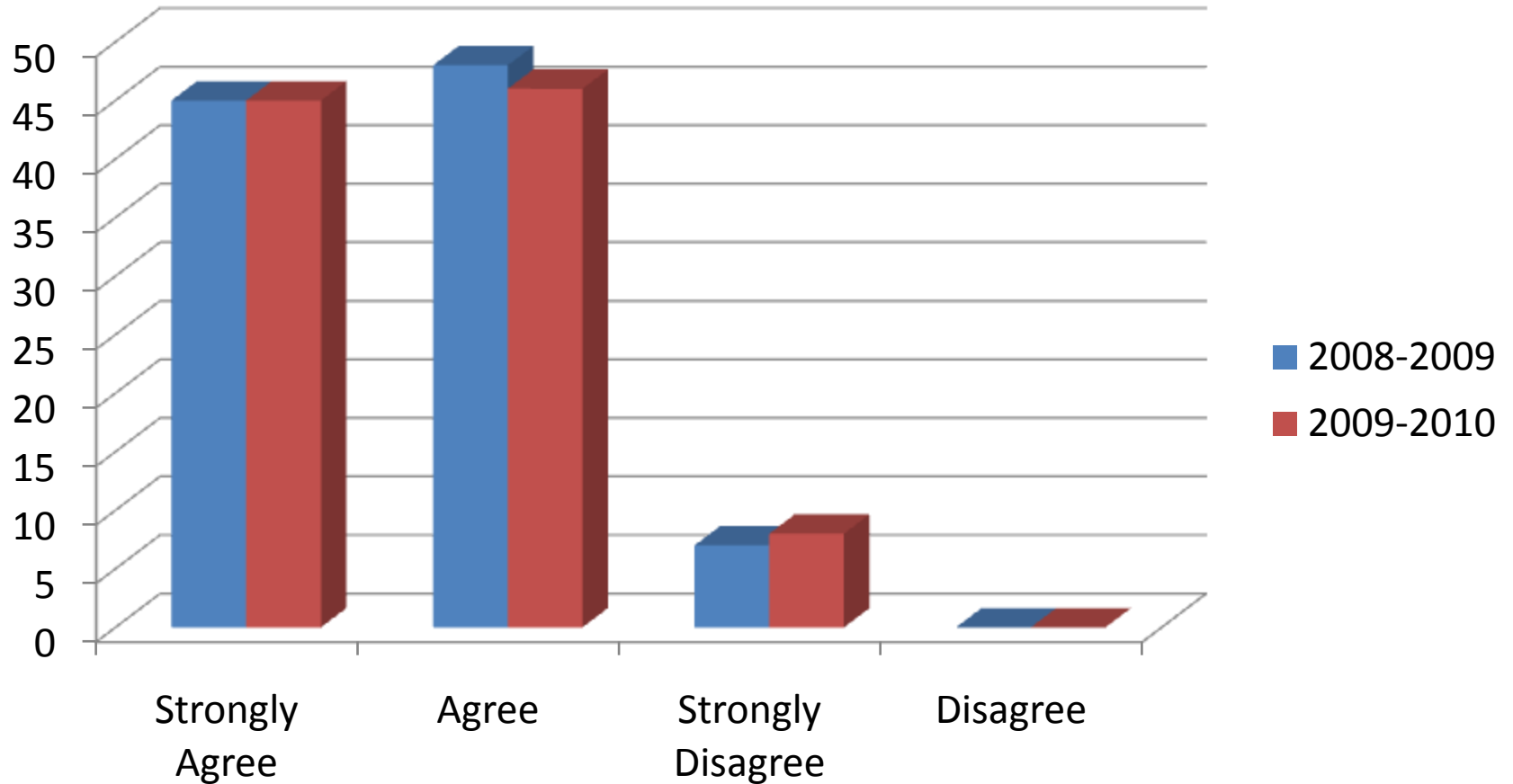

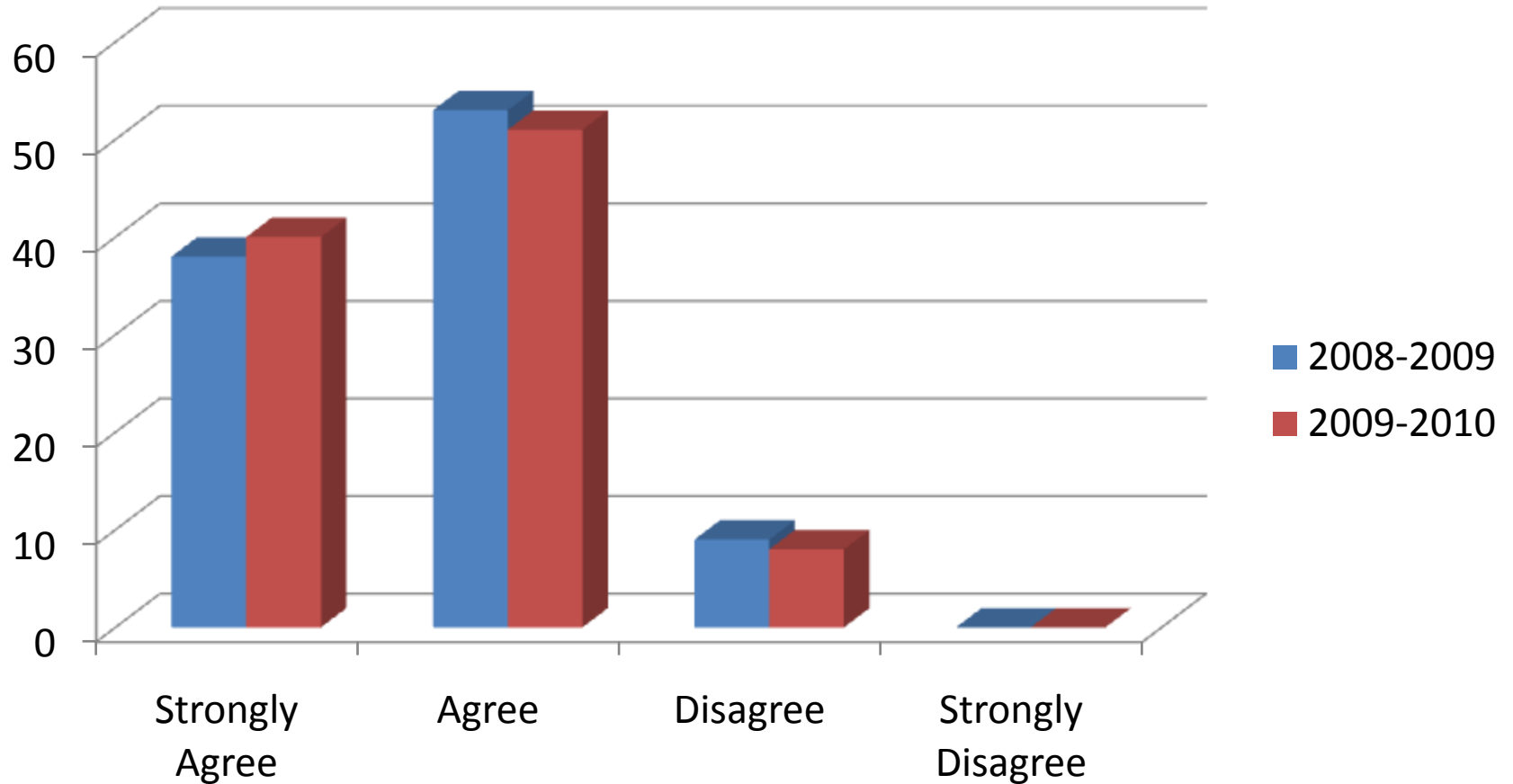

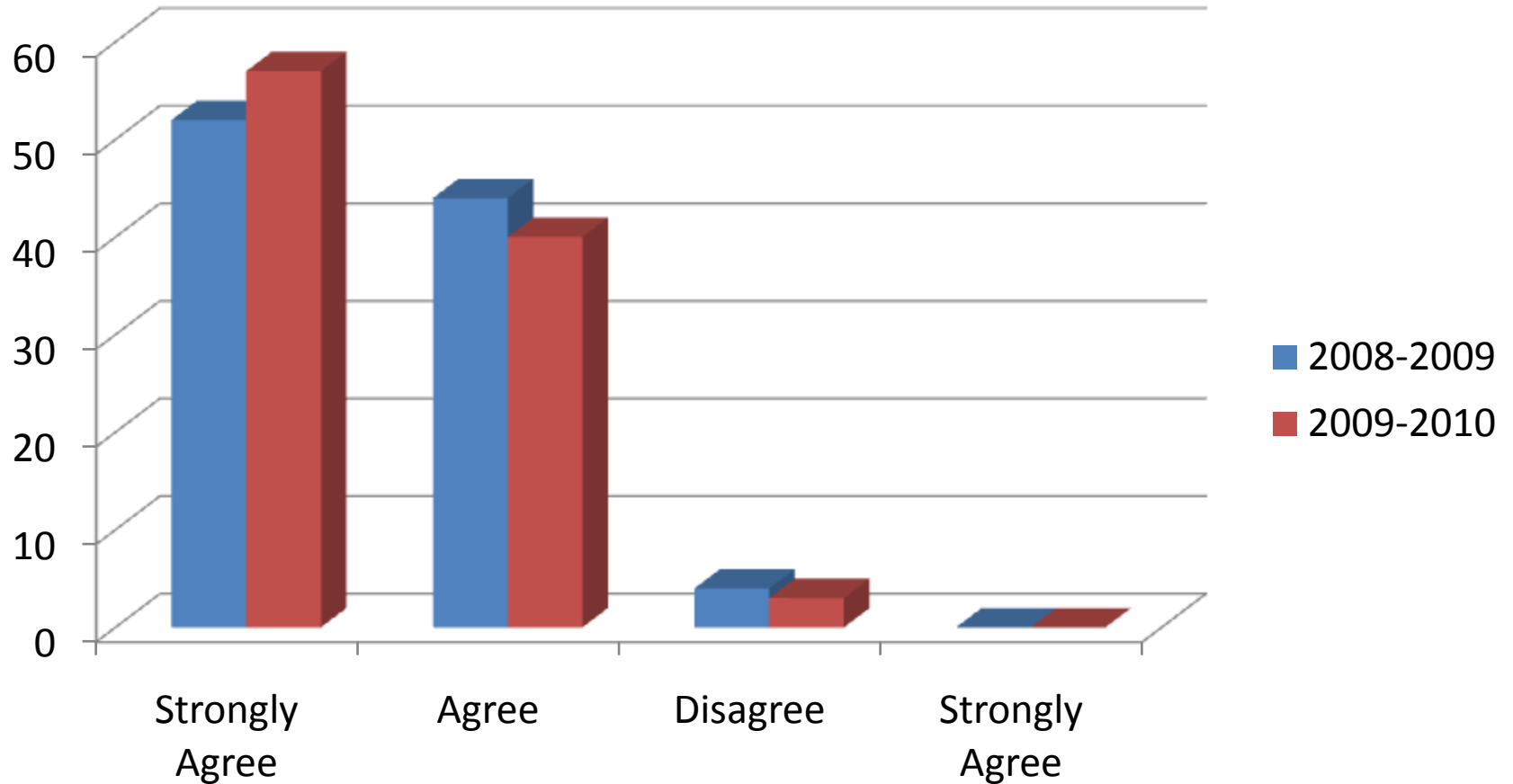

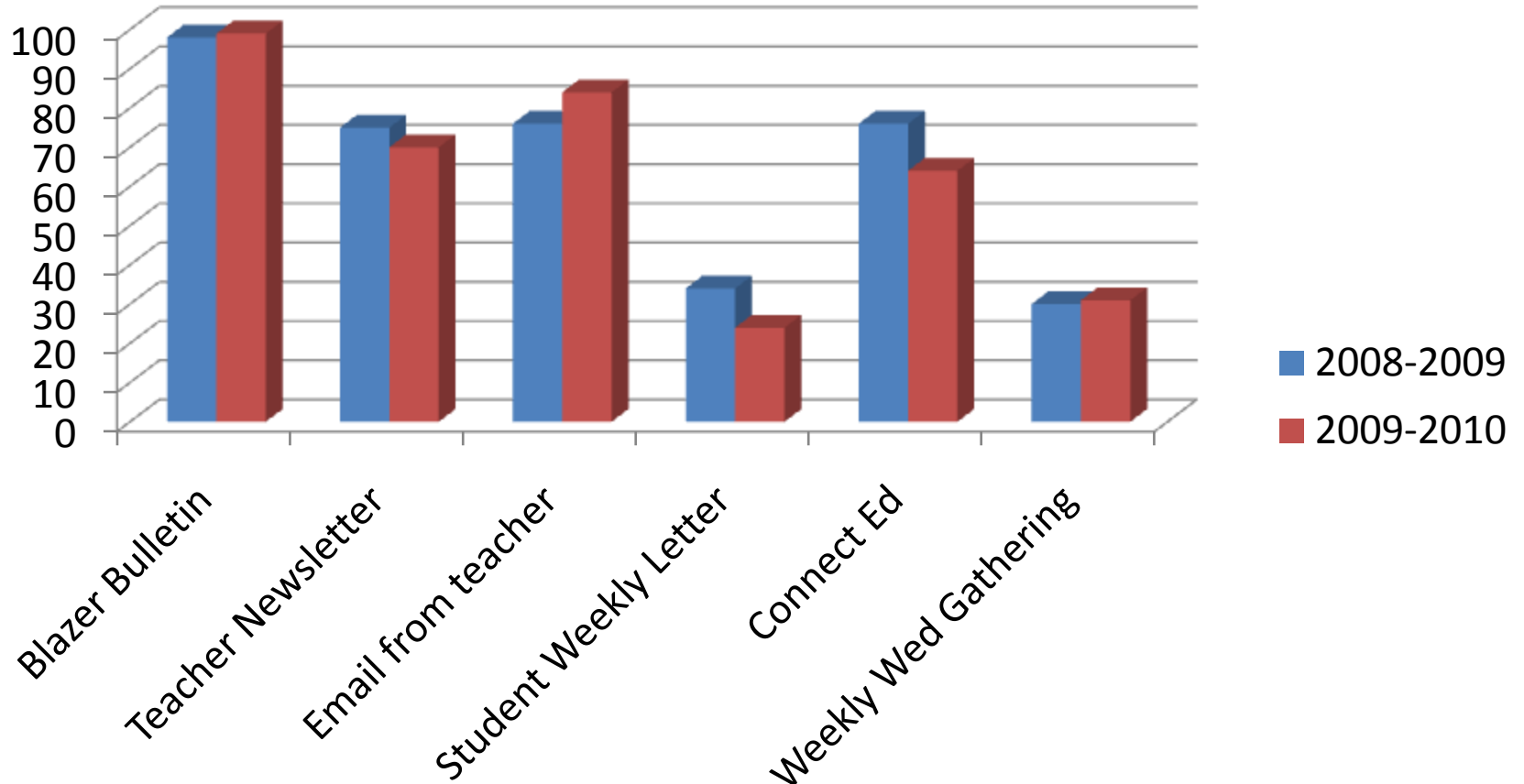
