

Twin Peaks Middle School
8th Grade Disneyland Trip Information
Saturday, March 24, 2012

Itinerary of Events:

1. Students will meet at Twin Peaks parking lot at 11:30 a.m.
2. Students **MUST** bring their ID cards in order to get on the bus.
3. Buses will leave at 12 noon.
4. Students will arrive at Disneyland approximately 1:30p.m.
5. Student **MUST** be back on their bus by 10:00 p.m.
6. Buses will leave at **EXACTLY** 10:30 p.m.
7. Buses should be back to Twin Peaks approximately 12 midnight.
8. Parents should be at TPMS by midnight and **NOT** blocking the bus drop off zones.

Eligibility Rules:

1. Students will follow all PUSD rules stated in the Student Planner.
2. Dress code regulations outlined in the Student Planner must be followed. There will be no jeans with holes allowed due to safety issues. Remember you are representing our school.
3. Students must be in good disciplinary standing and have a clean discipline record from 2nd Quarter until trip date. No U's in any 2 areas for example (2 U's in effort) from any 2 teachers. If you have 3 strikes you're out!

The cost of the trip is **\$90.00**. This includes entrance to the park and transportation. Make checks payable to **Twin Peaks Middle School**. If your student has a **Premium** yearly pass, then he/she may purchase **transportation only** for **\$30.00**. Be sure to check for black out days.

Tickets will be sold in front of the Student Store (room 407) at lunch on the following days: **Monday, February 6th through Friday, February 17th or until sold out.**

Tickets may only be purchased with the two signed permission slips.

Please download the permission slips from the TPMS WEB site under 8th grade activities.

TPMS Staff chaperones ride the busses up to Disneyland and then students are with their group of friends throughout the day. There is a Twin Peaks chaperone at the first aide station every hour during our visit. Students are instructed to report there if they have any problem.
