Poway Unified Announces Two School Site H1N1 Vaccination Clinics for Saturday, December 12

This coming Saturday, the Poway Unified School District, in Partnership with the San Diego County Health and Human Services Agency, will offer two H1N1 vaccination clinics for Poway Unified students and their siblings ages 6 months to 18 years of age and for pregnant women. These clinics will limit vaccinations to those priority groups as established by the National Center for Disease Control and the San Diego County Health Department.

On Monday, December 7th, parents of all Poway Unified District students will be notified via the District's automated voice and email system of the clinics and to expect an informational flyer being sent home with students. Early in the week students will be given the informational flyer each with a pre-printed individualized consent form on the reverse. Parents must bring the pre-printed consent form to the clinics when they accompany their children. If parents are bringing children for second dose, they must bring proof of the date when the first dose was given.

The two clinics are schedule for Saturday, December 12th, from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm, or until the allotted vaccines have all been administered. Vaccination will be provided to eligible participants free of charge, on a first come, first served basis. Screening and numbered ticketing will begin at 8:00 a.m. Clinic locations are :

Associate Superintendent Bill Chiment shared, "We are pleased to offer a second set of clinics for the students of Poway Unified. We still encourage everyone to work with their own health care provider to become vaccinated and to learn if the vaccine is right for them. With the current limited availability of the vaccine, we are restricted in who we can vaccinate. There are approximately 1,200 doses available at each clinic."
