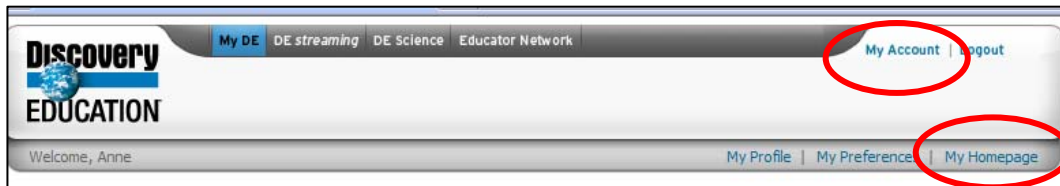
Part I: The Basics

1. Login

Your password: poway

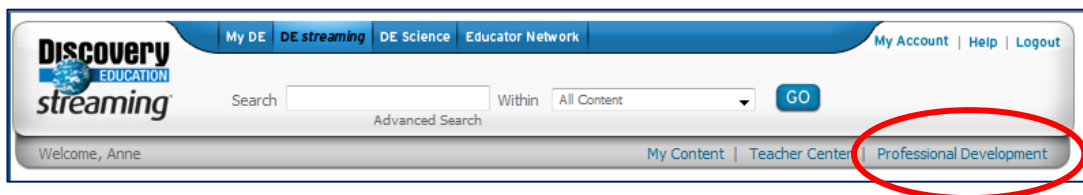
2. Personalizing your page will allow Discovery Streaming to find videos that are appropriate for your curriculum

1. Curriculum Standards Search

Discovery Streaming can help you find content that is correlated to curriculum standards. Use the drop down menus to select the appropriate results for your search. You will need to select a year for the standard as well. A list of curriculum standards will appear.

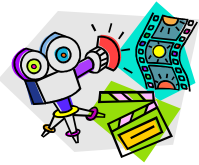
- Click on "Standards Document" to select different listings of standards.

2. Keyword Search

- Narrow your results by selecting **Image** on the left side. How many items were found?



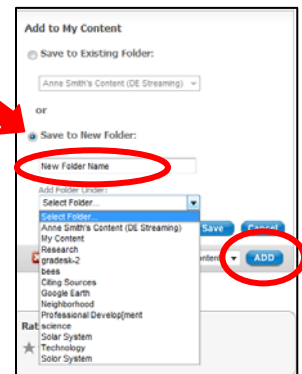
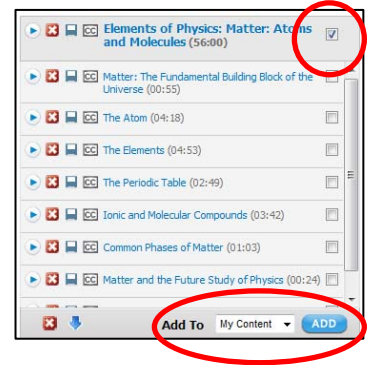

3. Save to My Content

To help you quickly retrieve videos that you have found you will want to save them to the **My Content** area. This is like a file cabinet for your videos.

- Find a video you would be interested in using for an upcoming unit in your classroom.
- Click on the video.
- Click the checkbox to the right of name of the video.
- Add to **My Content** by clicking the **Add** button.
- Be sure to create a folder to hold the various content that you find.

4. Advanced Search

- Click on the **Advanced Search** link.
- Fill in the appropriate items for your search.



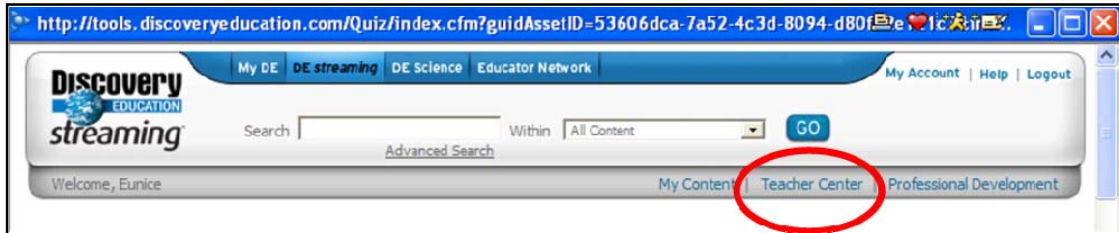

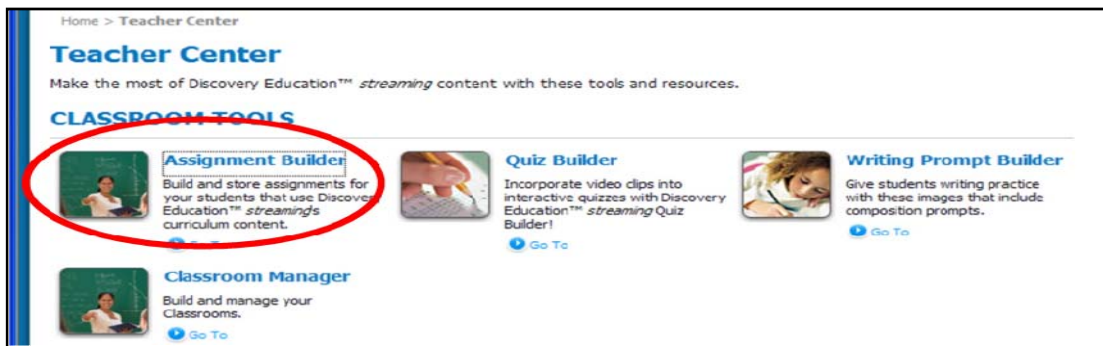

Part III: Teacher Center - Assignment Builder & Quiz Builder

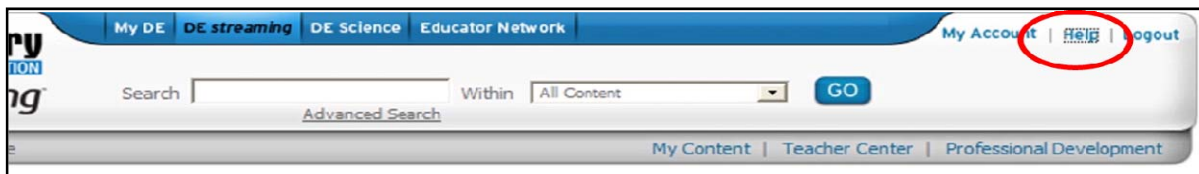
1. Click on the "Teacher Center" link on the Welcome Line.

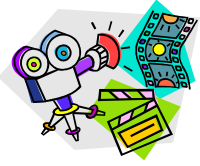


2. Click on "Assignment Builder."

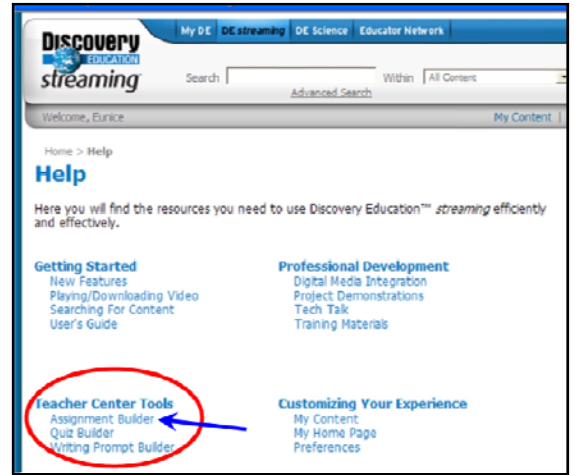
