Educational Programs & Activities

Academic Enrichment Support-

Funds after school math activity.

Arts Attack- Art program that provides the student different mediums such as clay, water colors and chalk in their exploration in creativity. Provides grade level materials to assist teachers in art curriculum.

Book Fair- Organizes and runs two Scholastic book fairs per school year enabling students, teachers and families to purchase quality reading materials, with all profit benefiting our Creekside library.
