

March will be a big month for High School Registration. Actual dates will be added as soon as they are available

When do I get signatures from teachers in different subject areas?

Students obtain recommendations from MBMS teachers using the following timeline:

LA teachers- March

Math teachers- March

Science teachers- March

Spanish, Band and Orchestra- TBD

When are the registration forms due back to my Social Studies teacher?

The forms are due back to Social Studies teachers in March . If registration forms are not turned in by students, the high school may select classes for you.

What if I need help completing the registration forms? What do I do?

First, be sure to read through the registration material provided by the various high schools and ask parents to help you sort through the information.

Second, visit the website of the high school you are attending for registration instructions and information.

Third, ask your teacher or counselor for assistance. Counselors are available before school, after school and during lunch for CRF questions.

Fourth, you may try to email or call a high school counselor for assistance.

What if a student wants to go to another school other than the one they are supposed to attend?

If a student wants to attend another school in the district, they will need to fill out and inter-district (IDT) form and submit it to the District Attendance Office at **15250 Avenue of Science, San Diego, CA 92128 as soon as possible. How do I get registration materials for a school that I want to attend?

If you have submitted an IDT application to go to a specific school but have not yet received a response from the district that it has been approved, you can get a copy of the Course Request Form (CRF) from the MBMS counselor.

However, because the district has not granted approval to attend the school, you will need to indicate "Pending IDT application" on the top of the CRF form. In any case, we encourage students/parents to still submit a CRF form for the school that you are supposed to attend based on district residential boundaries.

My teacher recommended and signed off on a class that my parent and I disagree with on the CRF form (i.e., Honors Biology vs. Biology or Algebra I vs. Geometry). What do I do if I want the recommendation changed?

The first thing is for the student and/or parent to speak with the teacher who made the recommendation about why the teacher made the recommendation. Hopefully, that discussion will lead to a common ground.

However, if parties still differ the parent should write a letter requesting the particular course they would like their child to be in and attach that letter to the CRF form. Students/ parents are not to change the recommendations that teachers have made on the CRF form.
