

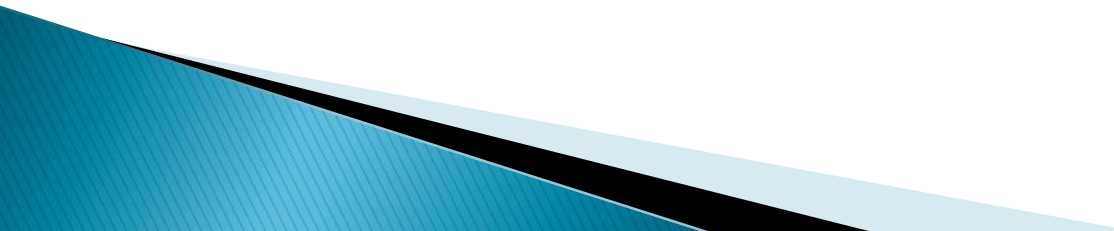

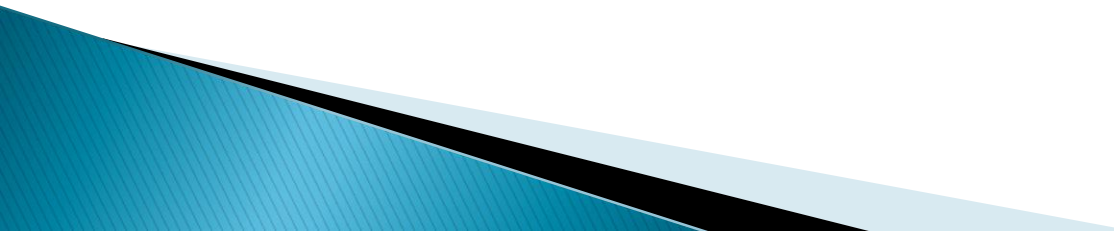

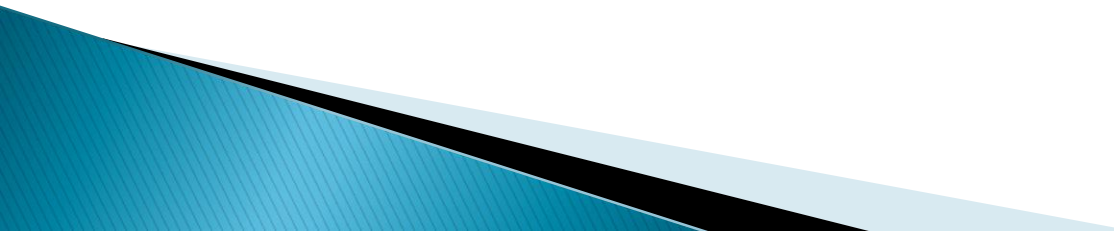
Students Using Lexia


5 Components of Reading Used in Lexia

- ▶ Phonemic awareness
 - ▶ Phonics
 - ▶ Fluency
 - ▶ Vocabulary

 - ▶ Model the skill
 - ▶ Provide guided practice
 - ▶ Provide independent practice
 - ▶ Assess

How to Log on to Lexia at Home

- ▶ Download Lexia using the school license code
 - ▶ Child can log on using their student ID number
 - ▶ There is no password
 - ▶ First log in the student takes a placement test
 - ▶ The child chooses from the skills at their level
 - ▶ Once a level is completed the child levels up!!
