A. Check each Course Request Form for:

1. Signatures for math, English, world language, as well as student, parent and contact teacher.
2. Six classes for each semester plus at least one alternate for elective (non academic classes)
3. Students taking a world language should be enrolled in High School English, or Honors English.
4. Appropriate science choices:
 - a. Biology is recommended for students enrolled in any level of math.
 - b. Honors Biology is not a class any longer.

- B. Check to see there are completed CRF's for every *eighth grader* enrolled at your school.**
1. If a student is **definitely** moving, write "moving" across the CRF. (we still need the form)
 2. If a student is absent or does not return the CRF, please contact home to discuss appropriate choices over the phone. The teacher should then fill in the CRF.
- C. Students will receive directions along with their CRF form about logging in to select classes online.**
