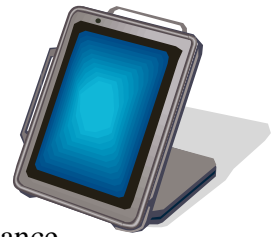

Mobile Communication Device



Tierra Bonita Elementary believes the use of mobile communication devices can enhance the students' educational experience. These mobile communication devices are not limited to laptop computers, but include students' *personal* mobile communication devices, such as iPads, iPod Touch, smart phones, Nook, Kindle, and other up and coming technologies.

Just as the students' personal mobile communication devices could enhance learning, these devices could disrupt the teaching and learning process. If a student's use of a personal mobile communication device is determined to be a disruption, parents and students understand that either the students will be asked to put the device away or it may be confiscated and returned at an appropriate time.
