Recycle Program

What can you recycle?

Any plastic or aluminum beverage container with a symbol that says **CA CASH REFUND** or **CA CRV**. Glass beverage containers are not accepted in the program.

How do you do it?

Please bring your empty beverage containers from home to drop off at our school on Tuesdays. Recycling containers are also available in every classroom.

- Last year, 7 billion bottles & cans ended up in landfills.
- CR&R has provided a storage container on our school campus to collect bottles & cans for California Redemption Value (CRV).
- Glass bottle are NOT accepted in the program.
- Plastic bottles must be bagged separately than aluminum cans in large clear plastic bags.
- Lids on plastic bottles are okay-but liquids must be emptied before recycling.
