MESSAGE FROM YOUR BOOSTER PRESIDENT

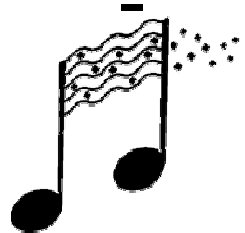

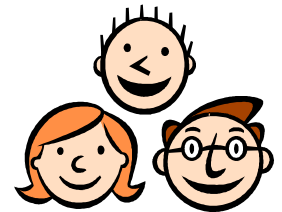

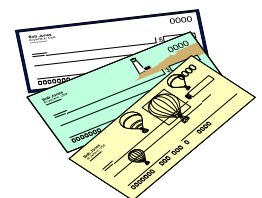

Westview's Percussion Ensemble tied for 5th place (out of 20 groups in our division) at the first competition held at Los Alamitos H.S. in Long Beach, Ca. The group performed well, had the entire show completed (musically) and really represented the Westview Gold Music Department in a fine manner.

The group worked hard since the end of 1st semester and even rehearsed during vacation time to prepare for the season. The group continues to improve and have fun.

STUDENT ACCOUNTS

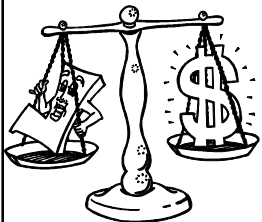

The Student Account list has been posted on the wall above the "White Box" in the Band Room. Only students with positive accounts are listed. The money in their individual accounts show balances from previous years in Westview Gold as well as from our first three fundraising events this school year which were Discount Cards, Entertainment Books and Poinsettia Sales.

"Student Accounts" provides each student an opportunity to earn funds to help defray musical expenses such as Fair Share Donations, uniforms (shirt, marching shoes, etc.), music lessons, music supplies, and banquet fees to name a few.

Fundraising activities are announced and a certain pre-determined percentage (decided by the Westview Gold Board Members) can be earned by the student and deposited into their account. The amount earned is accumulated for the duration of each student's academic career while in the Westview Gold program (marching band, concert band, orchestra, instrumental ensemble, color/winter guard).

In order for a student to withdraw funds from his/her Student Account, the student must completely fill out a Student Withdrawal Request Form which is located on the Westview Gold website. Only music-related expenses will be approved. All Fair Share Donations and other financial obligations must be taken care of prior to requesting funds for optional items. Required approval signatures include Parent/Guardian, Miss Webb, and the Band Booster Treasurer.

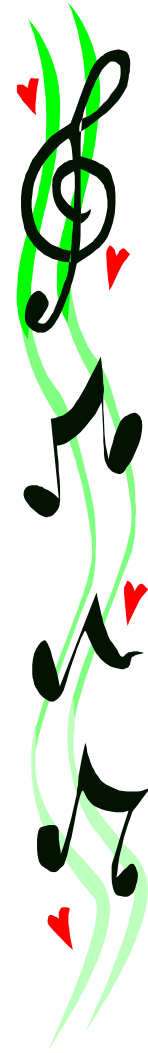
