<u>Week</u>	<u>Supplies Needed</u>	<u>Directions</u>
ONE January 26-30	Camera-digital or film	Use the camera to take several pictures of your home and family. You will want to include important rooms in your house and all the members of your family who live with you. Make sure to take pictures of the outside of your house and don't forget your pets! Get your pictures developed!
TWO February 2-6	Construction Paper – for cover (Provided)	Design an original cover (use your own art, avoid using computer generated clip art). Make sure you include a title (exp. The Anderson Family Book by Christopher Anderson). Make your front cover with the paper your teacher has provided . Turn in the cover to be laminated on February 13 th .
THREE February 9-13	Writing	Make sure you picked up your pictures. Choose 6-12 pictures and begin writing a paragraph about each picture on practice binder paper.
FOUR February 23-27	Final Copy Writing with paper provided	Write complete well planned sentences about each picture (paragraph). You should write at least 4-6 sentences about each picture. Make sure your writing is edited before writing your final copy. Your own writing not the computer.
FIVE March 2-6		<u>Complete your final copy writing and gluestick your photos above your writing. Don't forget "About the Author" page! Make sure that pages are in correct order. TURN IN ALL PAGES!</u>
