- A. Colonies wanted manufactured goods from Europe
 - 1) farm tools 2) guns and ammunition 3) pots and pans

- B. Cash crops were grown in the colonies to buy manufactured goods from England
 - 1) Sugar- West Indies
 - 2) Tobacco- Virginia/Maryland/Carolinas
 - 3) Indigo And Rice- Carolinas and Georgia
- C. In the South- Slave Labor 1750= 35% Southern Population is slave
- D. Tidewater- Coastal areas of the South that were flooded by Ocean Tides
